What's been happening: Recent highlights

Happy 2025 everyone!

It's been a while since our last newsletter, reflecting the very busy Autumn-Winter season here at Abbey. The highlight rounding off the end of 2024 was our December Community Lunch – our biggest yet, with 120 people joining us for excellent festive food cooked up by the kitchen volunteers, some premium tombola prizes, Tech Buddies IT help session, and best of all a glorious carols performance from our Abbey Community Choir. Only the week before that, the CNJ published an article about the State of the Borough research into loneliness which named Camden the loneliest borough in the UK, with 36% of us feeling 'lonely often or always'. We feel proud to be doing our bit to fight social isolation and improve mental and physical wellbeing. In fact, we published our 2023–2024 Impact Report and 2024 Evaluation Survey in Autumn (on our website 'Our Impact' page; we'll also be displaying it soon) and a massive 94% of you said Abbey helps you to connect with other people in your local area.
