

Abbey Community Centre's Covid-19 health and safety policies (from May 2022)

Although legally enforceable government measures have largely been lifted, we still have policies in place so we can help keep everyone safe. We're asking people visiting the centre to:

- Take a **lateral flow test** at home before attending. We can't enforce this, but do really appreciate it. Staff and volunteers are taking a test once a week when working at the centre. A list of pharmacies where you can pick up free tests is [here](#), made by our amazing intern Katie!
- Please do not visit the centre if you have **any** cold or flu symptoms – **even if you have tested negative for Covid-19.**
- Group sizes are limited depending on the size of room being used for the activity. **We advise you to book** to attend activities though some do have drop-in places.
- We are now open for walk-ins (the front door is unlocked and we welcome you to drop by), when fully staffed.
- **Masks** to be worn indoors at all times by volunteers, staff and tutors; they are optional but advised for members.
- Masks do not have to be worn outside if social distancing.
- **Hand sanitiser** available in centre
- 1 in 1 out in toilets
- We have **air purifiers** in each room which work to eliminate airborne Covid-19 particles.

We will review these on a monthly basis.
