

Abbey Community Centre's Covid-19 health and safety policies (from June – September 2021)

Although legally enforceable government measures have largely been lifted, we still have policies in place so we can help keep everyone safe. We're asking people visiting the centre to:

- Take a lateral flow test at home before attending. We can't enforce this, but do really appreciate it. Staff are taking a test every day they come in. A list of pharmacies where you can pick up free tests is [here](#), made by our amazing intern Katie!
- Groups of up to six indoors; people must book to attend activities.
- Social distancing in place in all areas of the building.
- Masks to be worn indoors at all times by members, volunteers, staff and tutors; if someone is exempt from mask they must wear a visor, provided by Abbey.
- Masks do not have to be worn outside if social distancing.
- Hand sanitiser available in centre
- 1 in 1 out in toilets
