

## **Abbey Community Centre's Covid-19 health and safety policies (from September 2021)**

Although legally enforceable government measures have largely been lifted, we still have policies in place so we can help keep everyone safe. We're asking people visiting the centre to:

- Take a lateral flow test at home before attending. We can't enforce this, but do really appreciate it. Staff are taking a test every day they come in. A list of pharmacies where you can pick up free tests is [here](#), made by our amazing intern Katie!
- Group sizes are limited depending on the size of room being used for the activity. People must book to attend activities.
- Social distancing in place in all areas of the building.
- Masks to be worn indoors at all times by members, volunteers, staff and tutors; if someone is exempt from mask they must wear a visor, provided by Abbey. Exceptions are our sports / physical exercise groups such as Table Tennis.
- Masks do not have to be worn outside if social distancing.
- Hand sanitiser available in centre
- 1 in 1 out in toilets
- We have air purifiers in each room which work to eliminate airborne Covid-19 particles.

We will review these on a monthly basis.
